



A43 Abthorpe Roundabout – Traffic Management Bulletin – 29th February 2016 Rev A

This bulletin will cover the traffic management restrictions for the above mentioned Project from 29th February to 6th March Inclusive.

Monday 29th February 2016 to 3rd March 2016 Inclusive - 0930 – 1530 Off Peak Working

A43 down to single lane running both Northbound and Southbound approaches to Abthorpe roundabout. Brackley Road single lane running on the approach and exit from Abthorpe roundabout. Abthorpe roundabout down to single lane running.

Friday 4th March 2016

No Traffic Management lane closures on A43 due to high traffic volumes.

Sat 5th March 2016

A43 down to single lane running Southbound approach to Abthorpe roundabout. Brackley Road single lane running on the approach and exit from Abthorpe roundabout. Abthorpe roundabout down to single lane running.

Monday 7th March 2016 to 10th March 2016 Inclusive - 0930 – 1530 Off Peak Working

A43 down to single lane running both Northbound and Southbound approaches to Abthorpe roundabout. Brackley Road single lane running on the approach and exit from Abthorpe roundabout. Abthorpe roundabout down to single lane running.



Friday 11th March 2016

No Traffic Management lane closures on A43 due to high traffic volumes.

Forecast for following week (Monday 14th to Friday 18th March 2016)

Daytime off peak lane closures on A43 southbound and northbound approaches and departures to Abthorpe roundabout with associated lane reduction on roundabout circulatory, Brackley Road and Abthorpe Road off the roundabout.

Full overnight closures (8pm to 6am) of Brackley Road between Abthorpe roundabout and Springfields/Belle Baulk roundabout on Wednesday 16th, Thursday 17th.

Springfields, Belle Baulk and Greenview Drive remain open.

Diversion signs will be in place to direct traffic to use A43/A5/Brackley Road.
