Below are the main crimes reported during July 2014:

#### **Grange Park Ward:**

**Theft from Motor Vehicle:** Electrical tools were stolen from Motor Vehicle in Loake Close. This happened between 8pm on 14 July and 7am on 15 July.

**Burglary in Dwelling:** Motor vehicle stolen from property in Woodlands. This happened between 10.30pm on 14 July and 6.40am on 15 July.

**Criminal Damage:** Damage to a property at School Lane. This happened between 6.50pm and 7.10pm on 16 July 2014.
