Wards covered in this update - Grange Park Ward

Main April reported crime:

Robbery – BP Garage – 5th May

Assault without injury – The Oaks – 9th May **offenders arrested**

Burglary Non dwelling- Lark Lane, Shed breaks - 10th May- 11th May overnight

Theft from motor vehicle - Foxfields way - 11th May van broken into tools stolen. **Still being investigated as CCTV of offence.**

Attempt Burglary non-dwelling, The Meadows, garage opened – 12th May

Robbery (personal) – School lane – 16th May **offenders arrested**

Criminal damage to motor vehicle – Bassett court - 22nd May

Assault with injury – Woodlands -23rd May **offenders arrested**

Assault with injury – Wake way - 23rd May **offenders arrested**

Possession controlled drugs - Badger lane – 28th May 3:00am **offender arrested**

Locally identified priorities:

You Said - ASB, Parking, Thefts from allotments,

We Did – we will look at key hotspot areas for Grange Park and focus patrols on those areas, we have the main park areas as active patrols anyway due to the nature of incidents that are normally raised in these type of communal use zones. Parking is always a concern however due to parking in south Northants being decriminalised we have limited powers on dealing with parking, for ongoing issues please contact highways and speaking with parking wardens. We can deal with obstruction of the footpath and of obstruction over driveways and drop down kerbs.

Thefts for the area, I have added this to patrol plan for the area and we have a key to get into the allotments if we see an intruder on site.
We have also been looking at places raised such as Baines way and Wake way.

IT'S A SCAM

Fraudsters want your money

- 1** A fraudster telephones you claiming to be from your bank or the police. They tell you that your bank is issuing counterfeit notes and that your help is needed in the investigation.
- 2** They suggest that you hang up and ring the bank/police back to ensure the call is genuine. **Don't be fooled** – they stay on the line. They then ask you to attend your bank and withdraw your money.
- 3** They send a taxi/courier to you to collect your money, which they claim will be examined forensically as part of the investigation. They will reassure you that your money will be returned.
