Main AUGUST reported crime:

Theft of pedal cycle- Cloverfield, 6th Aug between 00:30-07:15 stolen from back garden

Burglary in a building non dwelling Millers way 20th Aug 01:30-01:57 shed break in back garden

Criminal damage to vehicle The Spinney 22nd Aug 00:10 vehicle damage after party nearby where young people were not invited and when leaving the area have decided to cause damage to a vehicle in same street unrelated to party.

Attempt burglary Georges drive between 27th Aug 22:00-09:50 28th Aug climbed over wall have removed items and thrown them over the wall but left with nothing – **strong chance was disturbed**

Theft of pedal cycle Hazel copse between 30th Aug 20:00 - 1st Sep -07:30

Locally identified priorities:

You Said - ASB, Parking,

We Did – We have no reports of bad parking in Grange Park over the last month however my own observations have been that people are still parking over the pavement and across drop down curbs, I have spoken to several residents and visitors of the area and asked people to move their vehicles. This info has been passed on to the safer roads officer and if we feel vehicles need to be removed or given a ticket for obstruction we will do so.

We have had some reports of ASB in the woodland by the MUGA area, young people gathering in the buses no alcohol has been seen but we have taken reports of possible cannabis use.

We have also had a report of fires for the area and I will be looking at speaking with the youth club to try and educate young people on setting fires in the area as they have such large numbers attend I felt this would be the perfect opportunity to speak with a large population of young people within grange park.

Telephone Calls:

Do not give your telephone number to wrong telephone number callers. Ask the caller, "What telephone number are you calling?"

Check references of any person calling seeking information about you for a survey, credit check or subscription drive. Call the agency or company the person works for and verify the identity and intent of the telephone call

Never reveal to a stranger or wrong telephone number caller, your address or that you are home alone.

If you receive a threatening, harassing or obscene telephone call, notify the POLICE and your telephone company.

Place the phone down immediately. Do not say anything Keep a record of the date, time and the content of each telephone call.

Never give out any bank details to anyone over the phone including anyone claiming to be from your bank or POLICE, we would never ask for these details they are personal to you.
