There have been a small number of break ins to the Primary schools in the villages. PCSO Michelle Lee has been visiting the schools to make them aware of the problem and offer crime prevention advice. Michelle has spoken to some of the children about these problems. Further visits and patrols were conducted around Hackleton, Little Houghton and Yardley Hastings Schools.

Michelle visited Woodland View Primary School where she spoke to the reception classes. The children were shown around the police car and used some of the equipment it contains. They enjoyed the sirens. Michelle spoke about stranger danger, the importance of road safety and how to cross the road safely. All the children enjoyed the visit.

There have been incidents of Anti-social Behaviour in Carey Road, Hackleton. Those involved have been spoken to with their parents and we hope that the situation does not re occur.

Following an increase in reports of minor damage in Cogenhoe, Michelle and PC Mark Odams have increased their patrols. These patrols were targeted to the times the damage was being committed. Michelle is working with the local Neighbourhood Watch Group in an effort to identify those responsible. This seems to have resolved the issue.
