What do Street Watch members do?

- You patrol your local area for two hours every month, at times that suit you
- You will patrol in pairs, alongside one of your neighbours, talk to people you meet and encourage them to take an active interest in keeping your area safe
- So your neighbours know what you are there for, you will wear a high visibility Street Watch jacket
- Your local Street Watch co-ordinator will give you day to day support, so you know what to look out for
- You will also have support from your local police
